
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am writing to request \$1,980,000 for the Corvallis Backup 9-1-1 Center. The entity to receive funding is the City of Corvallis, located at 501 SW Madison Ave, Corvallis, Oregon 97330.

Funds will be used to purchase equipment for a fully functional emergency backup center with critical systems to include radios, Computer Aided Dispatch, and phone lines that are fully independent of the primary 9-1-1 Center. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the center will provide redundancy for emergency response services, allowing a seamless transition of call center operations and the uninterrupted protection of communities in the event that the primary 9-1-1 center is rendered inoperative.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding is for purposes described in section 1701(b)(8) of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10381(b)(8)). I certify that I have no financial interest in this project, and neither does anyone in my immediate family.
