As you begin crafting the Fiscal Year 2025 Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration and Related Agencies bill, I respectfully request funding for Maritime Welding Workforce and Training Facility project in Toledo, Oregon, in the amount of \$2,991,750 within the Committee's Community Project Funding Effort.
