
I am requesting funding for the Nye Beach Pump Station Modernization project. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Newport, located at 169 SW Coast Highway, Newport, Oregon 97365. The project is located at 426 NW Coast Street, Newport, Oregon 97365.

Funding would be used to upgrade the Nye Beach Pump Station by enlarging the existing wet well and installing larger pumps to address capacity limitations that can result in wastewater overflows. This project is a good use of taxpayer funds because it will help prevent raw sewage overflows onto the beach and into the Pacific Ocean, protecting residents, tourists and businesses that rely on a safe and healthy coastal environment.
