Dear Chair Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:


I am requesting \$800,000 for the Glide Revitalization Community Resource Center. The entity to receive funding is Glide Revitalization, located at 301 Glide Loop Drive, Glide, Oregon 97443.

Funding would be used to support the redevelopment of a building in Glide, Oregon, a rural community with a population of about 1,400 that was devastated by the Archie Creek fire in 2020. The community resource center will provide affordable childcare, office space for social service agencies and caseworkers, shelter during disasters, and a local library and youth programs.

This is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it consolidates essential services into one efficient center that supports recovery and long-term stability. Centralizing these community services will increase accessibility, reduce costs and improve disaster readiness.

The project has a Federal nexus because it is authorized under Section 306 of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, 7 U.S. Code section 1926(a). I certify that neither I nor my immediate family has any financial interest in this project.
